



Help shape the future of Kings County!

Kings County will hold a second redistricting public hearing on July 27, 2021 at 10 a.m. at the regular Board of Supervisors meeting.

Redistricting occurs every 10 years following the release of the Census results. It redraws district lines based on population changes indicated in the Census at the State, County and County levels.

Get involved in the County's redistricting process! At the hearing, community members will learn more about redistricting and how they can submit maps of their own. These maps could include borders of neighborhoods, a proposed Board of Supervisor district or the sketch of an entire countywide map of five Board districts.
