SUMMARY:

Overview:

The County will hold as part of its 2021 redistricting process five (5) public hearings to engage the public. At its fourth public hearing on November 3, 2021, the County will introduce and discuss the proposed maps prepared by the public and by the County's consultant National Demographics Corporation.

Recommendation:

Conduct the County's fourth redistricting public hearing to receive information from National Demographics Corporation about proposed supervisorial district maps and to receive public comment.

Fiscal Impact: None.

BACKGROUND:

The County will hold five public hearings as part of its redistricting process. The County previously held three public hearings on July 20, 2021, July 27, 2021, and August 31, 2021. The County is scheduled to hold the two remaining public hearings on November 3, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. and December 7, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. At the November 3, 2021 hearing, the Board will begin to analyze the draft maps to narrow and prioritize the map options for adoption at the December 7, 2021 public hearing. Maps that were submitted by October 20, 2021 will be part of the map review process at the November 3, 2021 hearing. These maps may be reviewed prior to the hearing at https://redistrictkings.com/draft-maps/. The deadline to submit maps to be considered for adoption at the final public hearing, scheduled for December 7, 2021, is November 22, 2021 at 5 p.m.

Beyond ensuring that each district represents about the same number of constituents, redistricting determines how neighborhoods and communities are grouped together for the purposes of electing a Board member. The adopted redistricting map will be drawn in accordance with the Fair Maps Act and AB 1276, which states districts must be:

- Geographically contiguous (each supervisorial district should share a common border with the next),
- Respectful of the geographic integrity of local neighborhoods or communities in a manner that minimizes its division,
- Drawn with easily identifiable boundaries that follow natural or artificial barriers (rivers, streets, highways, rail lines, etc.), and,
- Drawn to encourage geographic compactness with boundaries not drawn for purposes of favoring or discriminating against a political party.

Members of the community are encouraged to participate. Notice of today's public hearing was published on the County's website www.RedistrictKings.com at least five (5) days in advance. Notice was also formally published in the Hanford Sentinel on October 23, 2021 and October 29, 2021. The public hearing has additionally been promoted through an October 27, 2021 press release and online through social media. Flyers announcing the hearing have been posted online and distributed via email to local community groups and all others that have requested notice. Local groups have additionally received telephone calls apprising them of the hearing. Upon conclusion of the hearing, the County will make available online recordings or written summaries of the public hearing.
